GPA & Transcripts

The transcript begins with eight grade. Credit is given for high school level courses taken in 8th grade. The Grade Point Average is cumulative, and includes high school courses taken in eight grade, as well as all courses taken in 9th through 12th grade. All courses taken are included in the computation of GPA. All Pre-IB and Honors courses are designated with an H or Y in the course flag column of the transcript, and earn extra weight of 0.04 per semester, per course. All AP courses and senior level IB Courses are designated by a Z in the course flag column and earn 0.08 per course, per semester. The weight is added after the GPA is calculated in the usual manner—by dividing grade points by credits. The school year is divided into 2 semesters.

We offer 32 Honors course, 19 AP Courses and 43 IB Courses.

International Baccalaureate Program

The IB Program at Strawberry Crest was established in 2009, and was authorized to offer the Diploma Programme in February of 2011. The class of 2013 will be the first graduating IB Class.

Presently, there are 511 IB students:

Grade 9 = 161 Students Grade 10= 125 Students Grade 11 = 116 Students Grade 12 = 108 Students

The IB Program at Strawberry Crest is a magnet program that draws students from 15 middle schools and 6 private schools in Hillsborough County. Admission is by application only.

IB students attend IB and Pre-IB classes with other IB students, as well as traditional elective classes with traditional program students. They participate widely in sports, student government, honor societies, vocational organizations, service clubs, and fine art programs including band, chorus, orchestra, and drama with traditional students.

Rank in Class

Traditional students at Strawberry Crest are ranked within the senior class of the school. IB students are ranked county-wide because the IB Program is a magnet program, and students are drawn from the entire district. District policy prohibits the ranking of IB students within the Strawberry Crest High School senior class. Final rank is calculated in March of the senior year. Strawberry Crest High School has two valedictorians and two salutatorians—one from the IB Program and one from the traditional senior class.

Graduation Requirements for IB Students

All Strawberry Crest IB students are full diploma candidates. During the junior and senior years, a student takes three IB courses at the higher level (HL) and three IB courses at the standard level (SL). Generally speaking, higher level courses are taught in greater depth and standard courses are taught in greater breadth. Many students choose to add to their IB schedules with electives from the traditional program, such as music, ROTC, Journalism, and Agricultural Education, as well as courses from Florida Virtual School or Dual Enrollment courses with Hillsborough Community College. In addition to the course work, each student must complete 200 hours of CAS (Creativity, Action and Service), and write a 4,000-word independent research paper, called the Extended Essay.
