## You will:

- 1. Never argue with an official. If you disagree, have your team leader, coach or manager approach the official during a break or after the competition.
- 2. Control your temper. Verbal abuse of officials, sledging other players or deliberately distracting or provoking an opponent are not acceptable or permitted behaviours in any sport.
- 3. Work equally hard for yourself and/or your team. Your teams performance will benefit and so will you.
- 4. Be a good sport. Applaud all good attempts whether they are made by your team or the opposition.
- 5. Treat all participants in your sport as you like to be treated. Do not bully or take unfair advantage of another competitor.
- 6.Co-operate with your coach, team-mates and opponents. Without them, there would be no competition.
- 7. Participate for your own enjoyment and benefit, not just to please your parents and coaches.
- 8. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
- 9. Respect my coach and the decisions they make as I may not be aware of their overall strategy and plan.
- 10. Thank all officials, coaches, volunteers and parents for their support.
- 11. Be the best ambassador for my team, my sport and my coaches at all times.
- 12. Adhere to the skier responsibility code as set out by each individual ski area.
- 13. Attend every training session with a positive attitude.
- 14. Be responsible for providing, checking and maintaining my own safety gear.
- 15. Understand that failing to comply with any part of this code may result in (my child) being removed from the Snow Xchange training and sponsorship programme, Which, may result in and early termination fee.
