LOCAL RULES – LADERA GOLF COURSE

Out of Bounds: (Stroke and distance)

- All perimeter fences (Note: Perimeter fences are NOT obstructions, so you do not get relief)
- The club house and the concrete area around it

In addition to above, Out of Bounds on each hole is defined as follows:

Hole No.

- 1 To the right of the white stakes along the driving range.

Obstructions: (Note: Relief is for stance and swing only, one club length no closer to the hole, without penalty)

- All concrete, asphalt or gravel cart paths or roads
- All red, white, blue yardage markers
- Trees marked with a ribbon or tree wells filled with bark or any newly planted tree
- All pump houses, restrooms and buildings within the boundaries of the course.
- All sprinkler heads or sprinkler control boxes.
- All flower, native plant and rock beds.
- Flower/rock bed next to the building, pitching and putting greens
- Green silt fences
- Stones in bunkers are moveable obstructions. (Rule 24-1 applies)

Ground Under Repair: (Lift, clean and place)

- All area's outlined by officials with paint or other markings
- All irrigation construction areas
- All construction areas on the course that have left the area unplayable, whether marked or unmarked (newly sodden areas, piles of dirt from excavation, etc)
- Recent animal or bird diggings and droppings on the golf course
- All aerated areas. (May lift, clean and place not nearer the hole)
- You may lift, clean and place ball within the fairways and around the first cut around greens. Ball is played down in all other areas
- You may lift clean and place ball if it lies in a small rut or gully (even in the waste area on hole 17)

Water Hazards:

The lake on holes #9, #17 and #18 and the left of #6 and #16 are played as hazards (red). Lake in front of hole #16 and lake in front of hole #9 are hazards (red). The rocked drainage areas are part of the hazards. The collection area on hole #14 will be played as a hazard with the option to drop in the designated drop zone which will be the forward tee box.

Scoring:

A net score of 63 or lower will be posted twice.

Refunds:

No refunds will be granted once a person starts play.
