CLASSROOM ENTRANCE:

1. Get sketchbook/supplies from class storage.
2. Sharpen pencils.

Have this completed **BEFORE BELL RINGS**. Utilize this time to get organized for class!

JOURNAL/DAILY DRAWING TIME: VERY IMPORTANT STUFF!!!

1. No talking during this time.
2. Draw until the timer goes off.
3. Do not play with daily drawing items.
4. Stay seated during this time.

CLASSROOM BEHAVIOR and EAGLE EXPECTATIONS in the ART ROOM:

****S.O.A.R****

1. Be SAFE:
