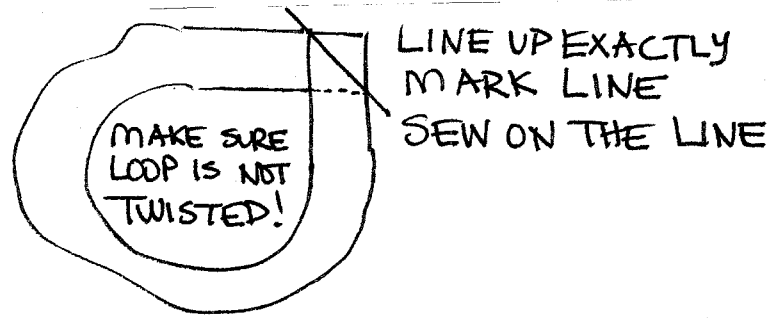
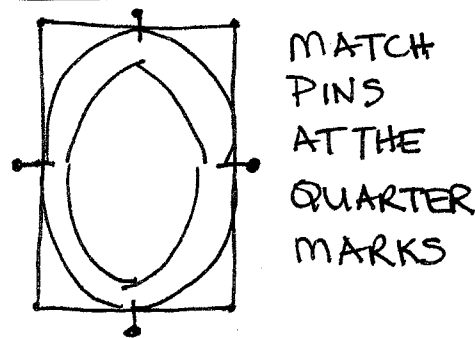


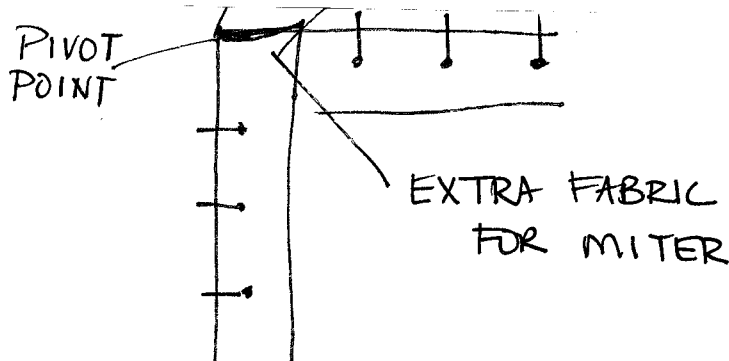
6. Join the ends as shown in the diagram (after making sure the binding isn't twisted).



7A. Mark the quilt top in 4 quarters by placing a pin at the halfway point of each side. Mark the loop in four quarters by folding and pinning. Match the pins on the quilt with the pins on the binding.



7B. Ease the binding in place and pin, so that the binding pivots at the corner just like always.



7C. As you sew, miter the corners as you go, pinning and re-pinning as usual. Finish the binding as you usually do or use my Accurate Machine Topstitched Binding method.
