Parent volunteers are vital to the success of the IB Partnership. Each year we enlist our volunteers to help with various events, most importantly our fundraising efforts. The SCHS IB Partnership receives no funding from the school or the school district. However, we provide the funds necessary to:

- Fulfill teacher grants for classroom enrichment supplies and activities.
- Provide Revitalization Events for students each grading period, such as Kona Ice Day and Recharge Breakfasts.
- Purchase pins and host the reception for the **Junior Pinning Ceremony, a major milestone in your student's path to his/her IB Diploma.**
- Host the **Senior Banquet, the culminating celebration of your student's completion of the IB Diploma Programme.**

We strongly encourage every IB family to volunteer for one of our major events. Students can volunteer and earn Action and Creative Hours as well:

_____ Annual IB Family Dinner and Bake Sale, 10-12 volunteers needed -- this annual event has become our welcome to the incoming freshman IB students and their families, as well as a meet and greet for our returning students and families!

_____ Junior Pinning Ceremony, 10 volunteers needed -- this is the IB student's official welcome into the Diploma Programme, and we host a "sweet success" reception for the students and their families after the ceremony.

_____ Adopt-a-Drop Site, 7 volunteers required -- we provide workers to the Supervisor of Elections to man an election drop site for the Primary and General Elections. It is a fun and profitable endeavor that also allows our volunteers to get a behind-the-scenes look at how our election process works!

_____ Holiday Gift Wrapping, 20-25 volunteers needed -- we get our jingle on every year and raise lots of money by wrapping gifts outside Toys 'R Us the two weekends before Christmas. We have developed a loyal customer base, and have lots of fun wrapping gifts -- but we need lots of hands to make this event a continued success!

_____ Strawberry Festival Parking, 20-30 volunteers required -- our volunteers work as parking attendants each day during the Strawberry Festival collecting parking fees and directing Festival guests (we do not 'park' cars). This is an extremely profitable event -- we earn 50% of the parking fees we collect!

_____ Senior Banquet, 10-12 volunteers needed -- our Senior Banquet committee members are responsible for planning this special evening. We are particularly looking for freshman, sophomore, and junior parents to help with this event so that we can grow a tradition for our seniors.

_____ Serve as a volunteer coordinator to recruit parent and student volunteers for our events.

_____ Assist with teacher luncheons by donating food or helping to serve.
