



GENERAL CAMP RULES

Solid Rock Camp and Retreat Center

1. Be nice.
2. Campers are not permitted outside these boundaries except with a staff member.
Boundaries are as follows:
 - On the North---the cleared easement along the road
 - On the South---the fence behind the Observatory
 - On the West---the tubing hill
 - On the East---the creek and the campfire area
3. No stone throwing. No tree climbing or climbing on any buildings.
4. No camper is permitted behind the counter of the store, the equipment check-out window, or in the kitchen at any time.
5. Campers are responsible for all sports equipment used. Please return all equipment to the equipment check-out window.
6. No showers or gatherings of campers in the washrooms after devotions at night; campers should stay in their cabins after the dark bell rings. Campers who must use the rest room during the night must be accompanied by a counselor and another camper.
7. Campers should not bother any animals they might see around the camp.
9. Shoes must be worn while on camp property, except in showers or cabins. Shirts must be worn in the Dining Room.
10. Campers should not be in any other camper's cabin unless invited and accompanied by the person making the invitation. Campers are not to be in cabins of the opposite sex.
11. Audio players, televisions, video games, cell phones, etc. are not allowed for personal use. Please turn these in to the office for safe-keeping. They may be retrieved at check-out on Friday evening.
12. Knives or weapons of any kind are not needed at camp and must be left with the camp office.
