PERMIT UNDER REGULATION 4 OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT AND POLLUTION CONTROL (MISCELLANEOUS NOISE) REGULATIONS 2004

I, Alexander Schaap, Director, Environment Protection Authority, hereby grant a permit in accordance with Regulation 20 of the Environmental Management and Pollution Control (Miscellaneous Noise) Regulations 2004 provided that the following requirements are complied with:

This permit is issued for a period of three years from the date of issue.



Requirements:

1. Maximum number of days permitted for powerboat racing, including test and tune activities, at the nominated venues are:

Venue	Maximum Number of Days
Horsehead Creek, Devonport	3
Granton, Hobart	8
The Domain, Hobart Regatta	2
Mersey River, Devonport Regatta	2
Tamar River, Rosevears	2

2. Vehicles and vessels covered by this permit must only be used between the hours of 10am to 5.00pm on the period that the permit is in force.
3. At the completion of the event you provide to me any complaints received regarding the event.
4. All vessels must comply with the requirements of the *Environmental Management and Pollution Control (Miscellaneous Noise) Regulations 2004*.
5. The noise levels of all participating vessels should be tested to show compliance with Regulation 17 of the *Environmental Management and Pollution Control (Miscellaneous Noise) Regulations 2004*.
6. Relevant authorities, including the EPA, are to be advised of confirmed event dates at least 2 days before each event.
