

#### Kenya - home to 1105 different species

Kakamega National Forest – over 350 species Amboseli National Park – over 420 species Lake Naivasha – over 350 species Lake Baringo – over 487 species Lake Nakuru National Park – over 500 species Tsavo National Park (East/West) – over 400 species Samburu National Park – over 350 species Maasai Mara National Reserve – over 500 species Mt Kenya – approx. 164 species

#### Tanzania - home to 1049 different species

Serengeti National Park – over 500 species Ngorongoro Crater – over 500 species Arusha National Park – approx. 250 species Ruaha National Park – over 450 species Rubondo Island National Park Lake Victoria – over 400 species Lake Natron Lake Eyasi Lake Manyara National Park – over 400 species Lake Tanganyika

#### Uganda - home to 1061 different species

Mabamba Bay Wetland at Lake Victoria Bwindi Impenetrable National Park – *approx. 350 species* Murchison Falls National Park – *over 450 species* Queen Elizabeth National Park – *over 600 species* Mgahinga Gorilla National Park – *approx. 180 species* Semuliki National Park – *recorded 441 species* Kibale National Park – *over 375 species* Rwenzori Mountains National Park – *over 177 species* Lake Mburo National Park – *recorded 350 species* Budongo Forest – *over 350 species*
