Legislative Update

from Janet Clesi, DCCRW Legislative Director

Restoring Rule of Law in Texas

Over a year ago, President Obama attempted to circumvent Congress and the will of the people by acting to unilaterally grant legal status to millions of undocumented immigrants (democrats). The State of Texas has born the brunt of undocumented children flooding across our border. The House passed H. Res. 639-which authorizes the Speaker of the House to file a brief in the Supreme Court supporting the position that president has acted in a manner that is not consistent with the duties under the Constitution and the laws of the United States

Texas is one of only 16 states that still require passenger motor vehicle inspection. Volumes of research show no safety benefit from state-mandated passenger inspections.

TX Senator Don Huffines sees this as nothing more than a tax and will introduce a bill to eliminate this waste of Texas citizens' time and money.

FDA has revised and expanded use of the abortion pill, formerly known as RU-486. The FDA's ruling lowers the dosage and thus the cost of the medicine, reduces medical supervision, and increases the number of days a woman can use the drug to ten weeks after beginning the pregnancy.

Having Trouble Getting To A Decision?

Once in a while, business comes before the club which elicits a lot of debate and many questions but the members are not ready to come to a final resolution.

What can be done at that point so that the rest of the meeting can proceed or so that the meeting can be adjourned? There are two motions that can get the club "unstuck."

First: Motion to Commit or Refer

This motion sends the pending question back to committee for more work or sends it to a new committee, if so stated. The motion can specify when the committee

will report back to the members for final action.

Second: Motion to Postpone to a Certain Time

This motion postpones the pending question until a future, specified meeting. When that future meeting arrives, the pending question is considered a Special Order and must be dealt with.

Either of these motions may be made by a member. They would be seconded and then voted upon. The president may suggest that one of these motions would be appropriate, if necessary.

There's no reason for business that "is going nowhere" to drag on and on. Send it back to committee for more work or postpone the decision to a future meeting. Then, get on with the rest of your meeting.

Important Information from Theresa Kosmoski, VP Bylaws:

As a result of convention, each club must ADD the following to their bylaws. In both cases, the verbiage needs to be added to "Article III - Policies"

1) In the subsection entitled "Candidate Endorsement", please add to the end of that subsection:
"No candidate shall use the TFRW logo in any political advertising, and any political advertising shall contain the following disclaimer: "This endorsement is given by the individual(s) only, NOT the Texas Federation of Republican Women."

2) Add a NEW subsection, and number accordingly, that states the following:
"Candidate Fairness: After the end of the filing period for any office and ending the day after the final election for that office, it is the policy of TFRW that all Republican

candidates for that office shall be treated fairly and equitably. When one Republican candidate for an office is invited to speak at a Federation or club meeting, then all Republican candidates for that office shall be offered equal presentation time at the same meeting or another meeting before the election."
