Dallas County Council of Republican Women is hosting its 4th biennial Power of Women to Elect Republicans POWER luncheon



The next Pac report is due to the Texas Ethics Commission (TEC) before midnight on Friday, July 15, 2016. For almost all clubs this report covers the period from the day after the date your last report ended through June 30, 2016. This semi-annual report is required to be filed whether or not a club has any activity.

Presidents cannot endorse candidates in contested party or non-

partisan races.
