Federal court rulings will allow voters in Texas and Wisconsin to cast ballots in November without government IDs.

The panel of judges did not strike down the law. The appeals court told the district court, which heard the case to find ways for voters without a proper ID to cast a ballot.

Obama's last act is to force suburbs to be less white and less wealthy. Housing Secretary Julian Castro, is cooking up a scheme to reallocate funding for Section 8 housing to punish suburbs for being too white and too wealthy.

News from TFRW



Protocol

from Annette Ratliff, TFRW Protocol Chair

Protocol can be defined as the "customs and regulations dealing with diplomatic formality, precedence, and etiquette." More simply stated, protocol is like a code of manners. As affiliates of TFRW, we should utilize proper protocol as we conduct our club meetings to ensure that our meetings and events run smoothly. When we follow proper protocol we establish credibility as club leaders and members, we honor our distinguished and special guests, and we bring respect to our organization.

But what is proper protocol for our club meetings?

First, there is an accepted order for ceremonial presentations at the beginning of a meeting:

God - Invocation

Country - Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag followed by the pledge to Texas Flag

Self - Introduction of yourself as presiding officer before proceeding

Tip #1 - Before the meeting begins, make sure you have the flags placed properly (U.S. Flag to the right of the speaker) and you have your prepared Agenda (that includes the order of the ceremonial presentations).

Tip #2 - Have your ceremonial presenters near to you for quick and smooth transitions.

An easy way to remember the order is to start with the GREATEST and end with the LEAST. Then follow the rest of your agenda which should include a welcome and introduction of guests, your program, and your business meeting.

In my next installment, I will cover more details about other elements of your meeting. Until then, always remember that "everyday protocol" includes friendliness, courtesy, and consideration. So keep your "please," "I'm sorry," and "thank you" handy at all times!

After amending your club's bylaws please send them to the TFRW VP Bylaws for review and approval. All clubs should have your TFRW amendments added to your bylaws. Your club gets points on the John Goodwin Tower Award for sending them in for review.

Club Presidents are the leaders of your club, but here are some reminders about your duties as per the bylaws:

Presidents cannot choose the club members to serve on the nominating committee.

Presidents cannot be an ex-officio member of the nominating committee.

Presidents cannot endorse candidates in contested party or non-partisan races.

Presidents can be the proud ambassador of your club and TFRW at any political and community event in your county!
