Legislative Update

from Janet Clesi, DCCRW Legislative Director

Obama has vetoed bill allowing 9/11 victims to sue Saudi Arabia.

Republican majority leaders in Congress are confident they have enough votes to override the veto. Senator Charles Schumer (D-New York) called the veto a "disappointing decision that will be swiftly and soundly overturned."

Saudi Arabia unsuccessfully tried to block the bill, using the services of its many lobbyists in Washington.

It is expected that Obama's veto will be overturned. Sadly, this will be first time in his presidential history that Congress has prevailed over Obama's wishes. Dallas Downtown RW


