If you missed the story on WFAA about Patriot Paws service dogs and the women inmates who train them to serve disabled veterans, you should watch it now.

(http://www.wfaa.com/news/community/inmates-vets-find-new-hope-through-service-dog-program/436874411) As the story points out, inmates and veterans may be two extremes of society but this training program gives new meaning to life for both.

The Texas Federation of Republican Women and the 2017 Convention Committee (chaired by our own Kit Whitehill of Coppell RW) has chosen Patriot Paws as the charitable component for our 2017 biennial convention that will be held in Dallas, Oct. 19-21. The initial plan was to raise donations through our clubs for Patriot Paws with the goal of raising \$30,000 by convention time – the cost of raising and training one dog for a veteran. The service animals are presented to the veterans FREE OF CHARGE and the wait list of veterans needing service animals is extensive. Well, by the time Belles & Boots conclude at TFRW's Legislative Day events in April, the goal had already been met! Additionally, Lt. Governor Dan Patrick pledged to help raise another \$30,000 for TFRW and Patriot Paws. We hope that our clubs will continue to "pass the hat" and collective raise


