Call for Nominations The 2011 Anita Hill Lifetime Achievement Award Presented Annual by the DCCRW

The Dallas County Council of Republican Women will present the 2011 Anita Hill Lifetime Achievement Award at the holiday tea Tuesday, Dec.6, at The Park Cities Club.

The award will honor an outstanding Republican woman who has consistently and continuously supported the Republican Party, its candidates and its goals, objectives and values year after year.

The award winner must have been a primary member of a Dallas County Council Republican women's club for at least five years, hold current membership in that club, and demonstrate a consistent Republican voting record.

The award is named in honor of the late State Representative Anita Hill of Garland, who served in the Texas House of Representatives from 1977 to 1993. She was an active community volunteer until she was encouraged to run for public office. Ms. Hill took pride in her work on behalf of the elderly and children that included nursing home regulation and mandatory children's safety car-seat use.

Past Anita Hill Award winners are Gwyn Shea, 2004; Betty Marquis, 2005; Ruth Potter, 2006; Jan Patterson, 2007; and Marty Forté, 2008, Taffy Goldsmith, 2009 and Susan Fischer, 2010.

The honorees' names are on a plaque at Dallas County Republican Headquarters, on the wall just outside the room where the DCCRW meets.

Early Voting starts Monday, October 24th. One of the advantages of voting early is that if you are registered in Dallas County you can vote in ANY early voting location in Dallas County. Following are the days and hours for early voting. NOTE: There are only two days when early voting is open from 7:00 A.M. to 7:00 P.M.

Oct. 24 through Oct. 28, 2011 8:00 A.M. - 5:00 P.M.

October 29, 2011 (Saturday) 8:00 A.M. - 5:00 P.M. October 30, 2011 (Sunday) 1:00 P.M. - 6:00 P.M.

Oct. 31 through Nov. 2, 2011 8:00 A.M. - 5:00 P.M. Nov 3 and Nov. 4, 2011 7:00 A.M. - 7:00 P.M.

If you want to know where you vote on Election Day or need a sample ballot, go to www.dalcoelections.org and click on "Check Your Voter Registration Status". Then put in your name and birth date or your voter i.d. #. If you click on "Early Voting Locations and other information..." you will find the Constitutional Amendment with an explanation of the amendment.
