





Rights, Responsibilities and Language!

There are certain rights with being a member of any organization. You have the right to pay your dues and be a member in good standing... and as long as you stay a member in good standing you have more rights!!!

There are three universal rights due to every member:

- Right to bring business to the floor (make a motion)
- Right to debate (give your opinion)
- Right to vote (let your voice count)

Many members are NOT AWARE of all of these rights

You have certain **responsibilities** as a member:

- Stay in informed of issues
- Be respectful
- Be knowledgeable
- Offer your comments
- Vote your choices
- Your responsibility to Know the language
- Know the RULES strategy, to accomplish goals
- Know the language
- Be Responsible to attend, to be aware and to vote!

Any game has its language:

Baseball: strike; pitch, ball; Home run; walk

Football: Punt; kick; huddle; defense; penalty; goal

Parliamentary language

Debate: discussion on 'pro' and 'con' of a motion

Question: Ready for the question? = motion

(Are you ready to vote on the motion?)

Germane: Wording relating to same issue

Division: Means to re-take vote; by standing is one way.

It is imperative that the presiding officer (sometimes referred to as the chair) to **be neutral in opinion** and govern according to the rules. The bylaws of the organization supersede the authority of Robert's Rules of Order Newly Revised.

It is most necessary for all members, especially the officers, to have a working knowledge of the Bylaws and any 'Standing Rules' of the organization.

Remember that all remarks by members must be addressed through the Chair. Avoid using another member's name. They are referred to as 'the member'.

Remember: Respect Courtesy Order in all meetings.




