



From the RPT website, dated July 29, 2015:

"The Republican Party of Texas (RPT) has called on Planned Parenthood to cease political activities in Texas until state investigations are concluded into whether the organization illegally profited off of harvesting baby body parts. Today, Planned Parenthood refused to testify in front of the Senate Committee on Health and Human Services but they did find the time to protest the hearing at the Texas Capitol. It's time to stop playing politics with baby body parts and start telling the truth."


