As a reminder, Article III, Section 5 of our bylaws states that: This organization and its officers shall not issue statements or pass resolutions on controversial issues in the name of the organization without first polling its members and obtaining a two-thirds (2/3) written vote of approval of the total membership.

This reminder is just to alert you to be thoughtful and measured if you go beyond, "No comment," in a response to a reporter, and to be clear that you speak only for yourself, not as a representative of your club or the Council as a whole.

Our current Republican Party of Texas State Chairman, Steve Munisteri, who was elected in 2010 and subsequently reelected in 2012 and 2014, has announced that he will be stepping down sometime in the next few months. Under the bylaws of the State Republican Party, it is up to the members of the State Republican Executive Committee (SREC) to elect a new State Chairman, who will serve the remainder of the current term until the next State Convention in May of 2016 in Dallas.


