31-Mar	Who am I?	Knowing yourself is connected to knowing your Creator	Ephesians 2:10; Acts 9:1-22	Knowing who you are is directly connected to how well you know the God who created you.	
7-Apr	Who am I?	Connecting with your Creator connects what was disconnected	John 15:4-5	If you want to become everything you were created to be, you need to stay connected with the Creator.	
14-Apr	Empty is a Good Thing!	Easter	Luke 24:1-8; Mark 8:31; Romans 6:6-11	Jesus is permanently alive and death will never overcome him again. When we decide to follow him instead of following our own selfish desires, we too can begin to really live!
