LOCK-IN RULES

****All youth must sign indicating their agreement to these rules****

- Unless other arrangements are made with a parent or guardian, each student is expected to stay the entire night, and will only be released to their parent or guardian with proper ID.
- No one is allowed to attend the lock-in without a signed parental permission slip and contact numbers. Parents may be called to verify if there is doubt.
- Lock-in participants will not be allowed to go outside of the church or venue without adult supervision, and if this rule is broken the parent will be called and expected to pick up their teen regardless of the hour.
- Special medication or required items should be indicated on the parent permission form.
- No cursing, illegal drugs, alcohol, dangerous materials, or firearms.
- All lock-in participants must respect others' physical boundaries. Inappropriate behavior (i.e. physical intimacy or sexual harassment) is not permitted.
- Boy only and Girl only sleeping quarters will be provided.
- It is expected that all lock-in participants (youth and adults) will participate in the program. Adequate free time will be scheduled for fellowship and socializing.
- Violation of these rules will result in disciplinary action and may include the participant being asked to leave the lock-in. Parents will be called to pick them up.
- Take care of yourself.
- Be considerate and respectful of other participants and leaders.
- Be respectful of the meeting place.
- Clean up after yourself.

THE ENFORCEMENT OF THESE LOCK-IN RULES IS EVERYONE'S RESPONSIBILITY.
