### **What to do when we're in need of a fresh start:**

#### **1. Leverage our \_\_\_\_\_.**

Isaiah 6:1 – *“In the year that **King Uzziah died**, I saw the Lord, high and exalted, seated on a throne...”*

Psalm 32:5 - “Then I acknowledged my sin to you and did not cover up my iniquity. I said, “I will confess my transgressions to the Lord.” And you forgave the guilt of my sin.”

I John 1:9 – “If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.”
