**Humanitarian Relief - Hurricane Dorian**

In early September, Hurricane Dorian devastated the Caribbean nation of the Bahamas, and caused significant damage in Nova Scotia and along the Atlantic coast of the United States. The hurricane moved excruciatingly slowly across the Bahamian island of Abaco, leaving most buildings and infrastructure destroyed. More than 70,000 people in the Bahamas are expected to need emergency assistance, including food, shelter, electricity and safe drinking water.

## SOLEMNITY OF ST. MICHAEL THE ARCHANGEL



The word 'angel' denotes a function rather than a nature. These holy spirits of heaven can only be called angels when they deliver some message. Those who deliver messages of lesser importance are called angels; and those who proclaim message of supreme importance are called archangels. Angels – messengers from God – appear frequently in Scripture, but only Michael, Gabriel and Raphael are named.

"The name of the archangel Michael means, in Hebrew, 'Who is like unto God?', and he is also known as 'the prince of the heavenly host.' He is usually pictured as a strong warrior, dressed in armor and wearing sandals. His name appears in Scripture four times, twice in the Book of Daniel, and once each in the Epistle of St. Jude and the Book of Revelation we learn of the battle in heaven, with St. Michael and his angels combatting Lucifer and the other fallen angels (or devils). We invoke St. Michael to help us in our fight against Satan; to rescue souls from Satan, especially at the hour of death; to be the champion of the Jews in the Old Testament and now Christians; and to bring souls to judgment." Infatti quei santi spiriti della patria celeste sono sempre spiriti, ma non si possono chiamare sempre angeli, poiché solo allora sono angeli, quando per messo loro viene dato un annunzio. Quelli che recano annunci ordinari sono detti angeli, quelli invece che annunziano i più grandi eventi sono chiamati arcangeli.

A essi vengono attribuiti nomi particolari, perchè anche dal modo di chiamarli appaia quale tipo di ministero è loro affidato.... gli angeli non hanno nomi particolari, che contraddistinguono le loro persone. Ma quando vengono a noi per qualche missione, prendono anche il nome dall'ufficio che esercitano. Così Michele significa: Chi è come Dio?...

Quando deve compiersi qualcosa che richiede grande coraggio e forza, si dice che è madato Michele, perchè si possa comprendere, dall'azione e dal nome, che nessuno può agire come Dio. L'antico avversario che bramò, nella sua superbia, di essere simile a Dio, dicendo: "Salirò in cielo, sulle stelle di Dio innalzerò il trono, mi farò uguale all'Altissimo, alla fine del mondo sarà abbandonato a se stesso e condannato all'estremo supplizio. Orbene egli viene presentato in atto di combattere con l'arcangelo Michele, come è detto da Giovanni: "Scopiò una guerra nel cielo: Michele e i suoi angeli combattevano contro il drago" (Ap 12, 7).
