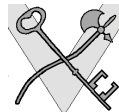

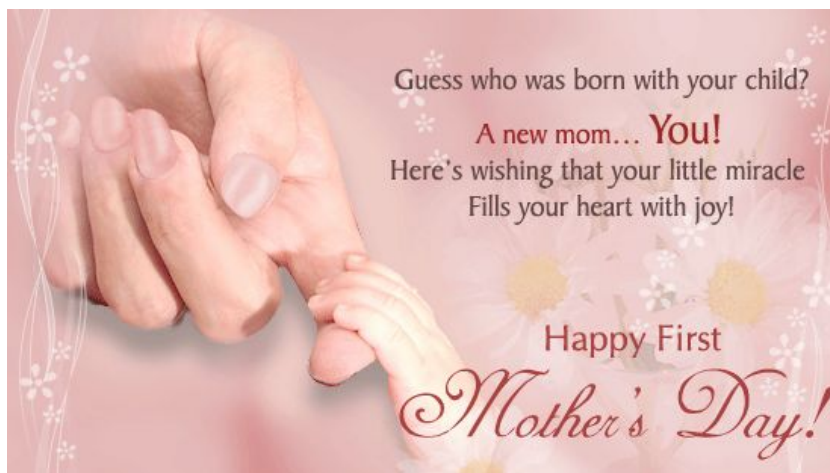
## Chaplain's Report - Fr. Jimmy Joseph

## Fraternal Report - Br. Chris Murphy



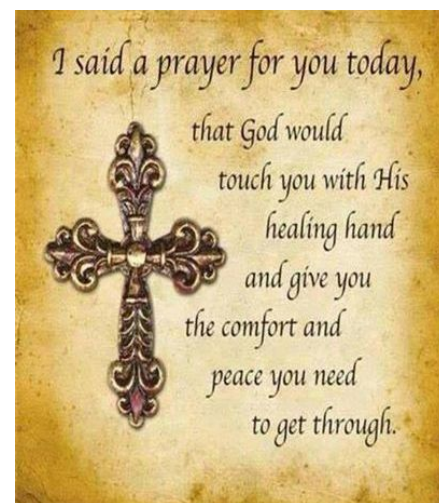

Responsible for the council's First Degree Team</p>	 <p><b>Deputy Grand Knight</b> Assists the Grand Knight with operation of the council and other duties assigned to him. In the absence of the GK, presides at council meetings. Serves on the council's Retention Committee</p>
 <p><b>Chancellor</b> Has the duty of strengthening the members' interest in council activities. Assists the grand knight and deputy grand knight with their duties as assigned. Recommended to serve on the council's Admission Committee</p>	 <p><b>Financial Secretary</b> is appointed for 3 years. Collects dues. Responsible for notices and retention. Ensures membership records are updated and new members sign the constitutional roll. Distributes honorary and honorary life membership cards. Files reports and membership/insurance transactions. Keeps the seal and affixes it to membership cards, resolutions, etc</p>	 <p><b>Treasurer</b> Handles council funds. Receives money from financial secretary and deposits it in the proper council accounts. Responsible for paying council expenses.</p>
 <p><b>Warden</b> assures that all members at meetings possess their membership card. Responsible for supervising &amp; maintaining council property. Sets up council chambers for meetings.  <p><b>Advocate</b> Acts as parliamentarian for the council. Should have a working knowledge of Robert's Rules of Order and Methods of Conducting a Council Meeting. When needed, will seek legal assistance from the state advocate.</p>	 <p>The <b>Inside Guard</b> and <b>Outside Guards</b> are charged with the security of the Council Chamber and assist the Warden in meeting the duties of his Office. Attend the doors of the council chamber, checking membership cards and allowing entrance</p>	 <p>The <b>Trustees</b> (three in number) oversee the financial transactions of the Council, review all bills and financial reports and audit the Council's financial records semi-annually.</p>
