Greetings and prayers to all of you.

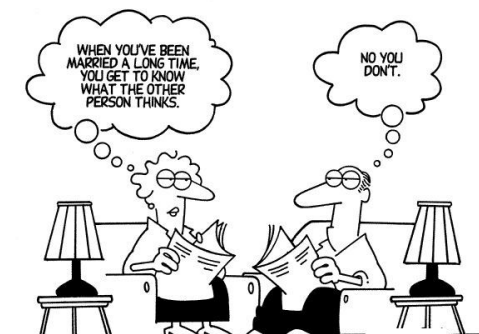

Hence, rather than merely memorizing material for an exam, students should be able to think critically and to critique information to plan and prepare reports. Reflective exercises help students reach the higher domains of learning. Learning how to be a self-directed learner is critical in an increasingly complex world.

Once the exams are over and the foundation is laid down for the forthcoming scholastic year, it is good to think about “The Holidays.” The holidays are a great time for us to step back from our busy day-to-day lives and to relax a bit with the family members. In our house, the holiday season has always been about family, about spending time with friends, relatives and loved ones.
