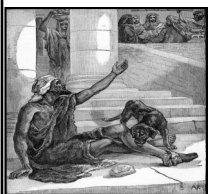


“YEAR OF MERCY”



Something to ponder....

‘We need the gift of faith.’

‘When Jesus rises from the dead, his disciples still cannot believe it. On the road to Emmaus, when the two disciples encountered Jesus, they didn’t recognise him. In today’s parable, Jesus says: “If they do not hear Moses and

the prophets, neither will they be convinced if someone should rise from the dead.” So at Emmaus Jesus teaches them about himself, as it says: “Beginning with Moses and all the prophets He explained to them in the Scriptures the things concerning Himself”.

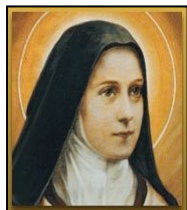
What Luke presents then is that seeing the risen Christ is not enough. The women disciples disbelieved out of fear, the apostles disbelieved out of joy. In the parable, if Lazarus alive was not enough for the rich man and his brethren, what good is Lazarus’s return from the dead? The real Lazarus, the poor man who dies outside the gate, is Christ himself. And Christ has come not to abolish the law and the prophets, but to fulfil them. Seeing the miraculous is not enough. We need the gift of faith, and it is a *gift*. And the gift of God should always be treasured and never taken for granted.’

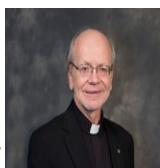

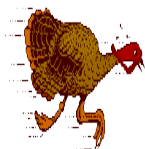
