Worldwide Marriage Encounter Weekend October 19th - 21st



Thank You For Your Generosity



Given the increasingly secular times in which we live, one can imagine how fragile conversations centered on marriage and family can be. That said, as Catholics, we are called to humbly and lovingly share God's teachings and reinforce our faith's mission in a world not always open to or familiar with the Good News.

Since the dawning of creation, God designed man and woman to both complement and unite with one another, bearing children as fruits of their love. In essence, two reciprocal halves are to become whole and combine to create new blessings.

In today's Gospel Jesus states clearly that marriage is to be an eternal bond between a man and a woman, with a loving and committed heart shared by both spouses. Any experience outside of this context or any human dissolution of this union, we can deduce, contravenes the will of God.

While marriage is designed to be unitive, Jesus illustrates its procreative nature when he embraces the children. His blessing and assurance of their entry into heaven invites us to equally welcome them as gifts of God.

While being sensitive and supportive to those in difficult situations, let us wholeheartedly strive to follow God's will for marriage and family, united as Jesus unites with his (Matt Charbonneau, Living with Christ) bride the Church.

Nel contesto della manifestazione del Figlio dell'uomo e dopo il secondo annuncio della passione, Marco espone come complemento catechetico - l'insegnamento sulla indissolubilità del matrimonio, e i comportamenti richiesti per fare parte del regno di Dio.

Gesù cambia scena (Mc 10,1): va in Giudea. Espone con autorità messianica - non a un gruppo ma al popolo - l'indissolubilità del matrimonio come un principio universale. San Marco non entra nelle discussioni dei rabbini sulla legislazione del divorzio. Coglie con fedeltà le parole di Gesù, senza tener conto della clausola eccezionale trasmessa da (Mt 19,9). Marco, rivolgendosi a comunità di gentili, e andando al di là del mondo giudaico, ricorre alla Genesi (Gen 1,27 e 2,24): nell'unione indissolubile del matrimonio brillano, folgoranti, l'immagine e la somiglianza poste da Dio nell'uomo e nella donna. Gesù spiega e chiarisce la volontà del Creatore.

L'atteggiamento di Gesù con i bambini fa trasparire la fiducia con la quale bisogna ricevere Dio come Padre (Abbà), la protezione e la sicurezza della paternità divina. Alcune tradizioni patristiche hanno scoperto nell'atteggiamento di Gesù con i bambini un'allusione implicita al battesimo dei bambini.
