



"They set out; and there, ahead of them, went the star that they had seen at its rising" - towards the place of the child who had been born king of the Jews. When the star stopped, the wise men were "overwhelmed with joy." They

entered the house and saw "the child with Mary his mother; and they knelt down and paid him homage."

We have heard this story many times. This would be the time, when our children were young, that we would bring out the tiny camels and the wise men and place them in our Nativity crèche. It would be the last act of our Christmas story. In a few days the small figures and other decorations still up from this joyous season would be carefully put away for another year.

Astronomers debate whether the star marked the arrival of a comet, a super nova or possibly a rare celestial conjunction of Jupiter and Saturn. Theologians note that only Matthew records the story, and some suggest it is a pious fiction designed to integrate older writings into the birth narrative of Jesus.

Questions abound but the essential message remains. For Paul, it is the mystery now "made known to humankind." Isaiah urges rejoicing: "Arise, shine for your light has come." The Epiphany reveals that Christ now had come among us to help us navigate our destinies.

Noi possiamo vedere la stella nella dottrina e nei sacramenti della Chiesa, nei segni dei tempi, nelle parole sagge e nei buoni consigli che, insieme, costituiscono la risposta alle nostre domande sulla salvezza e sul Salvatore.

Rallegriamoci, anche noi, per il fatto che Dio, vegliando sempre, nella sua misericordia, su chi cammina quidato da una stella ci rivela in tanti modi la vera luce, il Cristo, il Re Salvatore.
