Thank You For Your Generosity



What a fizzle the wedding feast might have been had Jesus not intervened! In today's Gospel, we see Jesus saving the couple's dignity by providing wine when they had run out. Jesus overcomes his reluctance to reveal himself at that moment, and he is exceedingly generous with the quality and quantity of the wine he contributes.

Indeed, Jesus is concerned for the dignity of every person. As I write this, I have come from a Sunday mass where a newly arrived refugee family was welcomed—a father, mother and three young girls. Each of the five said a simple "thank you" to the congregation which has given generously to help them through their first year in Canada.

They were migrants first, fleeing their home in desperation. I tried to imagine what they must have gone through and left behind, the patience and hope they surely needed during their long wait in a camp, and now the courage they will need to settle in a new country and learn a new language.

St. Paul reminds us that we are given the gifts of the Spirit to use for the common good. Today, as we remember migrants and refugees, let us resolve to use our gifts to give others their dignity.




