

MANDATORY WATER RESTRICTIONS



CA STATEWIDE EMERGENCY WATER REGULATIONS

1. **Limit outdoor watering to no more than two days a week.**
2. Applying (e.g., hosing or spraying) potable water to outdoor landscapes in a manner that causes runoff that flows onto adjacent property, non-irrigated areas, private and public walkways, roadways, parking lots or structures;
3. Using a hose to wash an automobile with potable water, except where the hose has a shut-off nozzle or device attached to it that causes it to immediately cease dispensing water when not in use;
4. Applying potable water to driveways and sidewalks; and
5. Using potable water in a fountain or other decorative water feature, except where the water is part of a recirculating system.

BPCSD STAGE ONE CONSERVATION RESTRICTIONS

1. **All residents and businesses may water lawns and landscapes only between the hours of 4 PM and 10 AM**
2. Use of water from fire hydrants shall be limited to firefighting and/or activities immediately necessary to maintain the health, safety and welfare of the District; and
3. All sales or use of District water outside of the District boundaries shall be discontinued; and
4. District potable water shall not be used to wash down sidewalks, driveways, parking areas, buildings or other structures, except to alleviate immediate fire or sanitation hazards; and
5. The washing of automobiles, trucks, trailers, boats, mobile homes and other types of mobile equipment with District potable water is allowed only when using a hose equipped with a shut-off valve so that water is not wasted.
