

BIG PINE COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT

HISTORY

The Big Pine Community Services District (District) was formed in 1968. The Wastewater Treatment Plant was financed with Clean Water Act grant funds and the sewer collection system was financed through a 25 year bond. Both projects were completed and went into operation in 1972.

In 1982, the District began operating and maintaining the water distribution system under a 10 year lease/purchase option with the Los Angeles Department of Water And Power. The District acquired ownership of the system and later, under the terms of the Inyo/LA Water Agreement, was reimbursed for the cost of the District's improvements to the system.

Currently, the District provides water and wastewater services to 348 residences and 16 businesses.
