

Course Overview

Students will be instructed on how to Read, Write and Perform with the Electric Bass Guitar and or Upright Bass.

Beginner Students

Beginning students will study the basics of reading (Sheet Music and TAB), as well as proper posture. Introduction to Beat, Meter, Tempo, Rhythm, Duration and pitch.

Intermediate Students

(2+) Years of experience in a class room setting or equivalent. Intermediate students will be instructed to the methods of sight reading (perform music from a score without having seen the score before). They will also go under a series of exercises to help develop specific bass techniques such as SLAPING, TAPPING, PLUCKING, SWEEPING etc. Introduction to Dynamics, Articulation, chords and harmony.

Advance Students

(Sight reading level of 5) Will be heavily conditioned in a 3 week program consisting of Fretting Hand Conditioning, Sight Reading/ Rhythm Lab, Technique Lab.

Modules

There are 5 Modules that consist of 5 lessons each being one hour long. At the end of every Module you will be provided with an exam. Each exam will determine if you are ready for the next module. Each exam will be performance based only. You will be provided with a set of 10 songs in the beginning of each module. You will choose 1 out of 10 of these songs to perform at the end of each module to pass your exam.
