Sermon Title / Heidelberg Catechism, Lord's Day 44 – Guarding Your Heart From Sin Q113: What does the Tenth Commandment require of us? A113: That even the smallest inclination or thought, contrary to any of God's commandments, never rise in our hearts; but that at all times we hate all sin with our whole heart, and delight in all righteousness.

Q114: But can those who are converted to God perfectly keep these commandments?

Q115: Why will God then have the Ten **Commandments so strictly preached since** no man in this life can keep them?
