Heidelberg Catechism, Lord's Day 52 — "The Covenant Oath"

Q127: Which is the sixth petition?
A127: "And, lead us not into temptation but deliver us from evil;" that is, since we are so weak in ourselves, that we cannot stand a moment; and besides this, since our mortal enemies, the devil, the world, and our own flesh, cease not to assault us, do Thou therefore preserve and strengthen us by the power of Thy Holy Spirit, that we may not be overcome in this spiritual warfare but constantly and strenuously

may resist our foes, until at last we obtain a

complete victory.

Q128: How do you conclude your prayer?
A128: "For Thine is the Kingdom, and the power, and the glory, forever;" that is, all these we ask of Thee, because Thou, being King and Almighty, are willing and able to give us all good; and all this we pray for, that thereby not we, but Thy holy name, may be glorified forever. Q129: What does the word "Amen" signify? A129: "Amen" signifies, it shall truly and certainly be; for my prayer is more assuredly heard of God, than I feel in my heart that I desire these things of Him.
