Sermon Title / Heidelberg Catechism, Lord's Day 21 – His Saints Forgiven unto Eternal Life Q 54: What do you believe concerning the "holy catholic church" of Christ? A 54: That the Son of God, from the beginning to the end of the world, gathers, defends, and preserves to Himself, by His Spirit and Word, out of the whole human race, a church chosen to everlasting life, agreeing in true faith; and that I am and forever shall remain, a living member thereof.

Q55: What do you understand by "the communion of saints?"

A55: First, that all and every one who believes, being members of Christ, are in common, partakers of Him, and of all His riches and gifts; secondly, that every one must know it to be his duty, readily and cheerfully to employ his gifts, for the advantage and salvation of other members.
