Sermon Title / Heidelberg Catechism, Lord's Day 23 – The Righteousness of Faith

Q59: But what does it profit you now that you believe all this?

A59: That I am righteous in Christ, before God, and an heir of eternal life.

**Q60:** How are you righteous before God?

A60: Only by a true faith in Jesus Christ; so that, thought my conscience accuse me, that I have grossly transgressed all the commandments of God, and kept none of them, and am still inclined to all evil; notwithstanding, God, without any merit of mine, but only of mere grace, grants and imputes to me, the perfect satisfaction, righteousness and holiness of Christ; even so, as if I never had had, nor committed any sin: yea, as if I had fully accomplished all that obedience which Christ has accomplished for me; inasmuch as I embrace such benefit with a believing heart.

Q61: What do you say, that you are righteous by faith only?

A61: Not that I am acceptable to God, on account of the worthiness of my faith; but because only the satisfaction, righteousness, and holiness of Christ, is my righteousness before God; and that I cannot receive and apply the same to myself any other way than by faith only.
