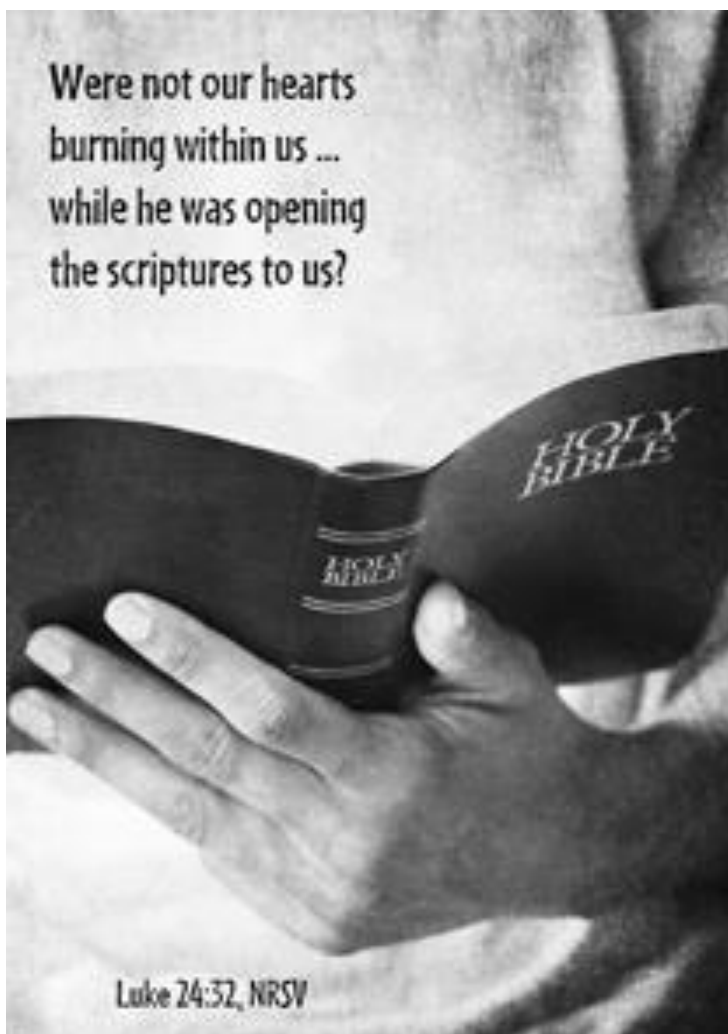

Q35: What is the meaning of these words "He was conceived by the Holy Ghost, born of the virgin Mary?"
