COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course will focus on Local Anesthesia as a refresher and update. It will also provide the student with didactic to review the block (Inferior alveolar nerve block, IANB) local anesthesia as many dental professionals struggle with this technique. The course will provide a review of basic pharmacology, medical concerns with local anesthesia administration and new techniques.

Course Objectives:

- Review local anesthesia pharmacology
- Discuss the concerns of the inferior alveolar nerve injection
- Troubleshoot for success of the IANB
- Determine the safest protocols for administering local anesthesia
- Increase comfort level and confidence in administering local anesthesia
