Watercolorist Karen Mills at January 18th Meeting and Julie Snyder at the February 15th Meeting



Karen Mills demonstrated her Chinese watercolor techniques at the January 18th meeting of the Santa Clarita Artists Association (SCAA). She painted a beautiful peony in a simple style, showing how to load the brush and make the correct brush stroke to create various effects for petals, leaves, and buds.

Acclaimed painter Julie Snyder will demonstrate oil painting at the February 15th meeting. Snyder's career has spanned both sides of the Atlantic and included several years of residence in Southern Spain. She forged her craft as an illustrator in advertising, publishing and the motion picture industry, including Warner Bros. Her work hangs in collections and galleries across the country. The National Art Museum of Sport honored her three times,

including her paintings of boxers Before the bell and Seeking the Target in their annual exhibits and awarding Snyder the prestigious gold medal for painting in 2013 for her painting Daily Drill. Her painting of chefs from the historic Blinn House Blinn House Kitchen Chefs hung in Contemporary Masters/Artistic Eden exhibition at the Pasadena Museum of History.



"I paint the figure, finding my subjects in many walks of life and I bring them into the studio to model. I love to recreate an impressionistic environment on the canvas that tells a story," said Snyder. <u>www.juliesnyder.com</u>



Masters of the American West at the Autry



The Autry's Masters of the American West Fine Art Exhibition and Sale is considered the country's premier Western art show. Each year, 75 nationally recognized, contemporary Western artists challenge themselves to create and exhibit their very best work. Stylistically and thematically diverse, their works represent the extraordinary range of subject matter that contemporary, historic, and mythic Western experiences inspire.

The 2016 Masters is dedicated to the life and legacy of longtime Autry trustee and Masters special advisor John J. Geraghty. Geraghty passed away on May 27, 2015, following a battle with cancer.

The exhibition is open to the public Tuesday through Friday, 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., and Saturday and Sunday, 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. The Autry is closed Mondays except for Presidents' Day, February 15.

START A CREATIVITY JOURNAL!

Santa Clarita Relay For Life Inaugural Luminaria Bag Contest

Unlike the traditional Luminaria bags that are dedicated in honor or memory of a named individual, the artist-designed bag will only illustrate the theme of the contest.

Second Place: \$150 in prizes - Your luminaria bag will be displayed at City Hall for the month of May

The entry fee for one luminaria bag is \$30, which is also a donation to the American Cancer Society to provide free services and programs for cancer patients along with funding ground breaking research to fight the disease.
