#### Marjorie Sarnat at SCAA June Meeting



On June 17th, Marjorie Sarnat demonstrated her "Uncommon and Amazing Techniques" at the SCAA General Meeting at Barnes and Noble. She discussed 23 different techniques to unleash creativity and showed samples of transfers, black mirror, glazes, and color relativity.

Another unique technique shown was to take close-up photographs from nature of items such as leaves, flowers, etc. then enlarge them and take a viewfinder to find an abstract composition for your work.



Sarnat also demonstrated various acrylic techniques such as using alcohol to make interesting effects and using different unusual items to make creative marks in the paint. Teresa LeClerc was the lucky winner of one of Sarnat's works.

#### American Veteran Traveling Tribute Vietnam Memorial Wall Art Project

On Sept. 26 through Sept. 29, the American Veteran Traveling Tribute Vietnam Memorial Wall will make Santa Clarita its temporary home. The Vietnam Memorial Wall in Washington, D.C., is a structure slightly less than 500 feet long and is etched with the names of over 58,000 servicemen and women who died in service during the Vietnam conflict, according to the National Parks Service.

Several privately own replicas of the Vietnam Memorial Wall are rented out across the country. The wall that will be standing in a parking lot of the Westfield Valencia Town Center is an 80 percent replica that has all of the names that appear on the original memorial etched into its marble face.

To augment the appearance of the wall, Westfield Valencia Town Center will present a display of art made especially for the week-long event. Eight artists are being sought to create patriotic/or non-violent Vietnam War tribute related works of art on white acrylic/plexi-glass hearts that will be prominently hung inside the mall space. Each heart is 6' x 6' and is 3/16" thick. Art work will need to be developed for both sides of each heart. A stipend of \$250.00 will be given to each artist for his/her work. The deadline for submissions is August 1, and artwork must be completed and delivered to Westfield Valencia Town Center by September 12, 2013.
