Eric Merrell at the January SCAA General Meeting

Eric Merrell, plein air oil artist, will demonstrate oil painting at the January 21st meeting of the Santa Clarita Artists' Association (SCAA). This event is free and open to the public. SCAA meets at 6:30 p.m. at Barnes & Noble, 23630 Valencia Boulevard.

"I spend a good deal of time on location to develop my color sketches and ideas, allowing myself the freedom to explore and dig deeper with each piece. Those sketches are used later in the studio to create

larger paintings. The on-location work is done with brushes, often through multiple sittings at the location, while the studio pieces are developed more slowly, allowing for other approaches including some palette knife application," said Merrell.

Merrell has appeared in publications such as American Art Collector, American Artist, the California Art Club Newsletter, Plein Air Painting and Southwest Art. He will be raffling a spot in his next workshop to all in attendance. You can see his work at <u>http://www.ericmerrell.com.</u>
