Great Volunteer Opportunity. Scholarship Committee

I have served two years on this Committee and find it exciting to see all the fine young artists and their enthusiasm. And, this is a very important part of our community outreach for the Association.

If you have an interest in this committee, the following is what is involved:

- 1. Going to each of 7 high schools to view student art. We make appointments with the teachers prior to going so we see only those students which fill our criteria. (A senior with plans for further arts education: fine art, teaching, etc.) About 1 hour per school. We photograph the art.
- 2. The committee chooses the winners. The Board has just voted to award a 1st Prize of \$1000 and a 2nd Prize of \$500. Also, we award Merit Certificates for the best student at each school.
- 3. Last year we had a Student Art Show which we hope to do again and might include hanging the Show, hopefully, in our Gallery for May or June.
- 4. At the Art Classic in October, invite the winners and award the checks.
- 5. Provide information to Publicity Chair for articles in the local media.

We need one or two more people to share these responsibilities for the Committee.
