WVAG OPEN JURIED SHOW 2013 – CALL FOR ARTISTS
 ENTRY DEADLINE FOR DIGITAL SUBMISSIONS IS MARCH 1, 2013
 The annual Westlake Village Art Guild Open Juried Show begins April 4, 2013 and runs through April 28, 2013 at the Thousand Oaks Community Gallery at 2331-A Borchard Road, Newbury Park. This major exhibit had well over 300 entries from outstanding artists last year.

All Artists are welcome and may submit up to three images of their work for the digital jury process. Digital submissions are due not later than March 1, 2013. Acceptance notifications available on March 15, 2013. All entries juried into the show will be hung in the Gallery and be eligible for cash prizes. The Gallery will be open Tuesday through Sunday from 11:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. during the show period. The WVAG will host a Reception and Awards Ceremony on Sunday, April 14, 2013 from 3:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. More information on this show and the digital jury process is available on the WVAG website at www.wvartguild.org.
