The SCAA received news that long-time member Rosalind Glass has passed away. Rosalind was born and raised in New York City. She began her journey in art by teaching summer camp in the Adirondacks and making clothing for fun. She realized she wanted to pursue the arts in her last semester of high school. She attended the famous Pratt Institute in Brooklyn and studied at the Art Students League until she was married.

After Rosalind moved from New York to Los Angeles in 1970 with her husband and two daughters she attended a meeting at the Beverly Hills Art Club and met Russian Master Painter Sergei Bongart. She learned from Sergei at his workshops and developed her love of painting portraits. She continued painting and attending various workshops, and in the mid-1980s joined the California Art Club. When she relocated to Santa Clarita, she became a member of the SCAA and won awards for her work.

We appreciate all the contributions Rosalind made to the SCAA. She will be missed.

Rich Brimer March Demo and Teresa LeClerc at April Meeting



Plein air oil artist Rich Brimer presented a demonstration to the SCAA on March 18th at Barnes and Noble. Rich demonstrated a still life of an abalone shell, which he painted on wood primed with 5 layers of gesso. He begins his works with an underpainting of transparent iron oxide or burnt sienna. He reminded the group that when painting from life, it's okay to move something around in order to improve the composition.



The April 15th meeting with feature a demo from pastel artist Teresa LeClerc. With her love for animals, it was natural LeClerc would choose pets and wildlife as her subject of choice. After years of drawing and pastel lessons, she began painting pet portraits and wildlife for her clients in the Antelope Valley and Oregon. In 2011 she was commissioned by Shadowland Foundation to paint portraits of their nine resident wolves in addition to other artwork for the Foundation. 








SALES TAX INCREASE
