This is the time of the year when we start the process of awarding our scholarships.

Our scholarships have always been based on ability and dedication but not necessarily on monetary need.

We try to make this as much as we can like our call to artists. Each high school (public & private) was contacted in February announcing the scholarship which is awarded to a graduating high school senior who will be pursuing an art career. We have seen students who are interested in everything from fine arts, medical illustration, design, animation to teaching art.

The students will next be notified to call us for an appointment to show us their portfolios. This year we have set aside two days at the end of April for these reviews. We have done the interviews at the Gallery for the last three years. We normally see less than 20 students who qualify. Because of the high school assignments (the students have been asked to concentrate on a theme) we often see the depth of the students ability in many mediums. As the students must send their original works to their prospective colleges and art institutes we do review photos of that work as well.

We are usually amazed at the quality of the work shown to us; some extremely talented kids. This year we are awarding a \$1,000 and two \$500 scholarships. With our healthy treasury, we will be asking the Board if they wish to further increase these amounts for this year.

This year's committee are Melissa Lackman, Patty O'Hearn and Pat Thayer.

This is such an important part of our organization. We appreciate the support the membership has shown to this endeavor for many years.


