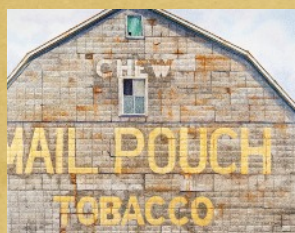

He has had his recent work "Americana" accepted into the yearly CPSA International Juried Exhibition to hang, in conjunction with the Convention, at the Carnegie Visual and Performing Arts Center in Covington. This is his fourth acceptance in five CPSA Internationals.
