

To really help the SCAA prosper and get new buyers to our events, it is important that you are forwarding e-postcards, invitations and announcements, asking your vendors to put a poster in the window, etc. If you have a Facebook page, please be sure to share all SCAA information on your wall and invite your contacts to events.

Though the SCAA would love to advertise more, these costs are expensive; the minimal amount made on member sales does not allow us a budget for this. We do send press releases to local news outlets and they have been very helpful, but they can not always get our events posted if there are paying advertisers first.
