The next General Meeting is scheduled for September 16th and will feature Yoti Telio, commercial and fine art photographer.


## **VOLUNTEERS STILL NEEDED FOR ART CLASSIC**

Many people have already volunteered to work on the event. We still need the following:


- 1. One or two wine collectors. Donations from members or wine makers or stores. Plus purchasing and delivering the wine to the event prior to the 19th.

# City of Santa Clarita Artist-in-Residency Program

The City of Santa Clarita is seeking two local artists to participate in an Artist-in-Residency program at two of the city's Elementary Schools. The artists will develop and implement an interactive art project for West Creek Elementary and Rosedell Elementary in the Fall of 2013. Artists will create a piece of art while on-site at each school. During the residency, the artist will be required to present a talk about the art making process, with specific attention given to the art piece being created during the residency, at two assemblies. At the conclusion of the residency, the artist will present the finished artwork to students at two assemblies, and discuss the process of its creation.

August 26 – 30 Interviews by Selection Committee

September 2, 2013 Two artists selected for the Artist-in-Residency Project September 23, 2013 to September 27, 2013 - Residency at Rosedell Elementary September 30, 2013 to October 4, 2013 - Residency West Creek Elementary
