ART CLASSIC CHECK-IN ON OCTOBER 16TH IMPORTANT REMINDERS

Some things to remember when dropping off your submissions on October 16th from 4-7 p.m. for the Art Classic:

- If submitting two 2D pieces, they must each be no larger than 27" x 27" (including frame)
- No wet paintings
- Work must be wired and ready to hang; absolutely no saw tooth hangers allowed
- If painting is not framed, canvas edges must be painted
- Sculptures requiring a pedestal must be provided by the artist
- A 20% commission will be paid to the SCAA for any artwork sold at the Art Classic
