## October General Meeting at Barnes and Noble with Helene Jukoff



Artist Helene Jukoff demonstrated her acrylic painting techniques at the October 15th meeting. She painted a vibrant beach scene by putting down the complimentary colors for the undercoat so the scene would "sparkle". Helene used a palette knife for the work, explaining that spreading the paint is like spreading peanut butter on bread. She also starts with her darks when working with opaque colors and discussed the importance of knowing what makes up the colors you are trying to mix (hue, temperature, chroma, value, and whether it is an earthy color). Guest Roberta Luster was the lucky raffle winner of one of Helene's works!

The November 19th meeting will feature the 2012 Art Classic winners discussing their winning pieces! This is always a not-to-be-missed meeting, as members get to hear how their fellow artists developed the visions for their work. Most of the artists and the winning pieces will be in attendance.
