Advent, Christmas, New Year, the trees went up, the lights went up, the ball dropped, the lights went down, the trees went down – now all is calm again, right? Wishful thinking!



The world around us seems to witness changes in a speed never seen before. And those changes are impacting our lives and our neighbor's lives greatly: Which news can I trust? Will I be insured tomorrow and how? Will Social Security and Medicare be cut? Can my mother-in-law come to visit us? What will our international relationships look like in half a year? - and so on, and so on. Fear is creeping into many people's hearts.

So to those who were able to come to the conversations after worship and to those who were not able to join us, here is a timely recap:

Change is situational and external, change happens. Change causes transition which is the internal, psychological process to deal with change. Transitions are made. For Gethsemane Lutheran Church radical change happened when Pastor Gloria retired after 21 years of ministry in this place. Now you are transitioning into the new you. Yet, like the three Magi, you are carrying valuable gifts with you: gratitude for a successful ministry, hope and trust in your community, and a well-kept facility.

The interim journey began. But with the words of T.S. Eliot: "What we call the beginning is often the end. And to make an end is to make a beginning. The end is where we start from." You started something new with an ending! It is part of our human nature that we like familiarity and continuity far better than change and the unknown. So be reminded that whatever comes next in the transition to the new you, you are walking as well-equipped and supported children of God. There is a larger church walking with you. And, rooted in Baptism, all of us are breathing a loving, compassionate Spirit.

Therefore we are not limited by the winter storms of recent days. When we look ahead, we will not give into seemingly overwhelming waves of fear and anxiety. The one, born for us in poverty in a dark winter night, will calm the storm. He is asking in a moment of calm: "Why are you so afraid?" And later he will add: "I am with you always."

I trust his word!

Endowment Distributions for 2016

The Gethsemane Lutheran Mission Endowment Committee was able to make one distribution this past year from our investment proceeds. We are very proud of the great organizations (many of which we have supported in the past) that we were able to assist for the following programs and activities:

- 1. TACO-They are raising funds for a lift to their second-floor offices to aid those staff and clients with mobility issues. Amount \$500.
- 2. Agape House SDSU-They are starting a food pantry for students who are food insecure (of which there are many). Our donation will fund four movable shelf units and basic supplies to help establish the Agape Pantry. Amount \$500.
- 3. Fisher House (Naval Medical Center-SD)-They provide a well-needed service locally (and nationally at other military hospitals) to support recuperating military heroes...similar to a Ronald McDonald center where families can stay during their loved one's hospitalization. Amount \$500.
- 4. Warrior Foundation-Freedom Station-They provide excellent service locally to medically discharged military members transitioning to civilian life. Amount \$500.
- 5. ELCA Missions-We funded various "ELCA Good Gifts" projects including purchasing chicks, a rooster (thus providing even more chicks!), goats and honey bees for those in need of a nutritious, sustainable food source. Other worthy ELCA projects we supported are for water purification tablets, farming tools, fruit trees, cook stove, refugee food and supplies, and teaching a health care team. Amount \$1,500.
- 6. Gethsemane Capital Improvements Fund-As a follow-up to the recent parking lot improvements, GLC is now considering additional outdoor lighting options to enhance safety and security. Amount \$500.

Remember that Endowment donations are never spent, only the proceeds (capital appreciation and earnings), so the money keeps on giving. The funds are conservatively invested through American Funds.

If you are interested in furthering our outreach, the process is easy. Just write a check to Gethsemane Lutheran and mark for Endowment Fund and the money will be transferred to that account. The Endowment is a perpetual investment fund to further worthwhile needs apart from the general Church budget. 
